Transmission due to contact between individuals and surfaces	Everyone	<p>Groups will share toilet and shower facilities those these are cleaned and checked on a regular basis daily</p> <p>Hand sanitiser facilities will be provided at the entrance to all toilets and must be used by anyone entering and leaving the premises. Face masks must be worn by everyone aged 11+ in any indoor setting unless exempt.</p> <p>Signage will be in place reminding everyone to wash their hands regularly.</p> <p>Paper towels/ hand dryers for drying hands will be available.</p> <p>Facilities will be kept well ventilated i.e., fixing doors open where appropriate.</p> <p>Toilets will be cleaned daily. Where surfaces require disinfecting, we will use an antiviral disinfectant that is effective against Coronavirus; certified European standards B:2013 + A2:2019. Virucidal mist will also be used.</p> <p>Additional cleaning and sanitising will take place in areas of high congregation and frequent touch points/ surfaces such as door handles/ push plates.</p> <p>Appropriate cleaning supplies will be readily available for staff and accompanying visitors to enable easy access for self-service cleaning as required</p> <p>When cleaning the toilets staff/ volunteers will be required to wear the appropriate PPE i.e., mask and gloves.</p>		<p>Check daily that signs are still in place</p> <p>Recorded</p> <p>Recorded</p> <p>Guidance issued upon request</p>
